How to use the urban bus service

Plan your journey

Use the map at the front of this book to find your current location and the best route to take to your destination. You can find the times your bus line runs by referring to the relevant timetable in this book. Alternatively, you can use the Transit app to plan your journey or call Horizons Regional Council on freephone 0508 800 800.

Catching your bus

Be at the bus stop five minutes before the bus is expected to arrive. Remember, you can use the Transit app for real-time tracking of your bus to see how far away it is. Stand on the footpath near the front of the bus stop. Some bus stops are used by more than one route, so check the route number and destination displayed on the front of the bus as it approaches. Raise your arm as a signal to the driver that you want the bus to stop.

On the bus

For your own safety and comfort, as well as those around you, please:

- Follow our Code of Conduct.
- Do not smoke/vape, eat food, play loud music, or leave items in the aisle.
- If the bus is busy, please offer your seat to someone who may need it more than you – for example someone who is older, pregnant, or travelling with young children.
- If standing, please take backpacks off and put them at your feet, or in the luggage storage.
- Relax and enjoy being driven.

Leaving the bus

Press the button as you approach the stop where you want to get off. The bell rings, letting the driver know you want to get off at the next stop. Please ensure you allow enough time, when pushing the button, for the driver to stop smoothly and safely at your requested stop. Remember to tag off, otherwise you may be charged the cash fare. Please check you have all your belongings with you before leaving the bus.

Transferring between buses

You can catch a second bus for free within one hour of your original trip (not available for return trips). Simply tag on and off each bus using your Bee Card and the free transfer will be automatically calculated. If you are paying by cash, let the driver know on your first bus you wish to transfer and they will give you a paper ticket to show the driver on your second bus. Fares will be based on the more expensive leg of your journey.

Frequently asked questions

Help! I've left something on the bus. Who do I call?

Give the bus operator (Tranzit) a call on 06 355 4955. Please note, no responsibility will be accepted by the bus operator or Horizons Regional Council for lost property.

I am a UCOL student or staff member, how do I catch the bus for free?

You may need to load your free travel concession on to your Bee Card. Please check with your tertiary provider. Remember to carry your student/staff ID with you when travelling.

Buses are wheelchair accessible, what does that mean?

Wheelchair accessible buses are low floored with no steps to climb up, and there is enough room for wheelchairs to fit. Please note, if your wheelchair takes up a space of more than 700mm wide and 1200mm long and/or has a combined weight (passenger and chair) of more than 300kg, it cannot be carried.

Can I take a bike on the bus?

Yes, the bus can carry up to two bikes on a rack which is on the front of the bus, on a first come first served basis. The rack is designed to carry bikes weighing under 25kg each and with wheels larger than 16 inches. Where a rack is not available and your journey is at a time that there is the space for your bike onboard the bus, it may be possible for you to store it in the luggage area. Note this would be at the driver's discretion. Horizons accept no responsibility for damaged bikes. Visit goconnect.org.nz for more information.

Can I take an e-scooter on the bus?

Yes, you can. However, it will need to be placed clear of the aisles. If your scooter is in the wheelchair area, please remember wheelchair users have priority.

How do I know where my bus is?

Download the Transit App to plan your journey and track your ride in real-time.

Where can I see all the stops on my route?

All the bus stops for a route show on the Transit app.

Can I take my pet onboard buses with me?

Yes, your pet is allowed onboard with you, provided you follow these criteria for your pet:

- Dogs must be secured on a lead and be wearing a cage-style muzzle, or be secured in a suitable pet carrier.
- Small pets must be secured in a suitable pet carrier.
- Pet carriers need to be securely placed within the luggage storage or on their caregivers lap – pets are not permitted on seats.

The bus driver has the authority to refuse entry or remove pets and passengers if they believe they are a nuisance or a health and safety risk to themselves and/or passengers. Visit goconnect.org.nz for the full policy and guidelines.

Public holiday?

No bus services operate on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or ANZAC Day. On all other public holidays, services operate according to the weekend timetable.

Changes?

Horizons Regional Council plans and operates services according to the timetable; road conditions, traffic calming measures, special events and weather may cause delays or may result in detours.

Fare zone map

How to use this map

Once you cross into a different colour on the map from where you started, you pay for that zone's trip when you tag off.

For example, travelling from Papaioea Palmerston North to Aorangi Feilding is a two-zone trip.

Places which border a zone, such as Bunnythorpe, are a one-zone trip.

*Concession fares apply when using a registered Bee Card.

Concession groups are: Children aged 5-18, tertiary students, ages 65+ and people on Total Mobility scheme for disability. Please note: carers of people using the disability concession travel for free.

Child cash and Bee Card fares are different.

** Community Connect is for Community Service Card holders with a registered Bee Card.

*** SuperGold free concession applies 9am-3pm and after 6:30pm Monday-Friday, and all day on weekends and public holidays. Otherwise, SuperGold Card holders must pay the concession price (with Bee Card) or Adult price (with cash).

Fare capping

If you tag on and off with a registered Bee Card, your travel becomes free once you make a certain number of trips each week (Monday – Sunday).

Within zone travel is a one-zone journey. Places which border a zone are a one-zone journey (e.g. Bunnythorpe).

If you hit your cap for trips through multiple zones, then you will get free travel for smaller trips. For example, someone commuting daily between Papaioea Palmerston North and Aorangi Feilding (a two-zone trip) during the week will have free travel on the Aorangi Feilding Orbiter 301 services (a one-zone trip) or on Papaioea Palmerston North's fully electric network (a one-zone trip) from Thursday evening each week.

Fare capping is based on an individual's travel, activated by tagging on and off. You can still pay for other people's travel with your Bee Card, but this does not contribute to accessing the fare cap.

Transfers

Free transfers are available across all services within the region. This includes free transfers onto urban buses from regional routes.

As long as you are catching the second service within an hour of catching the first one, the transfer is free. If you use a Bee Card, this process is automatic – just tag on when you get onto your second service. You will be charged the fare for the most zones from the two services travelled.

If you are paying by cash, make sure you ask your driver for a paper ticket. Then on your next bus, show the driver this ticket for your free transfer.

Bee Card



What is a Bee Card?

Bee Cards are our electronic bus card. Bee Card makes travelling by bus easier – get your card online at beecard.co.nz, or on the bus. Bee Cards need to be registered to enable online top up, and to protect your balance if you lose your card. You can also manage multiple cards online.

How much does it cost?

Bee Cards cost just \$5 to purchase. A minimum of \$5 top-up is required, and can be done with cash on the bus or online with a card. All replacement cards cost \$5 (includes postage/admin), and require a top up of \$5 or more.
